Dr Daghish graduated in Medicine from the University of Edinburgh. He completed his basic Psychiatry training in South East Scotland. He moved to Bristol in 1998 where he became a Lecturer in the Psychopharmacology Unit of Bristol University working for Professor David Nutt. Dr Daghish immigrated to Brisbane in 2007 to take up the post of Senior Lecturer in Addiction Psychiatry and Director of the Alcohol & Drug Service, Royal Brisbane & Women's Hospital. This service comprises a large inpatient detoxification unit, a Consultation-Liaison service and a Drug & Alcohol Brief Intervention Team in the Emergency Department.

Dr Daghish has had a professional interest in Drugs & Alcohol since his undergraduate years, when he undertook an elective in a detoxification unit in West Berlin. His research interests are centred on functional neuroimaging of the neurobiology of Drug & Alcohol addiction.
